

Choral Collaboration!

The Canadian Chamber Choir is a national professional-level choir whose singers come from across the country. Choirs and vocal programs from local schools are invited to join the CCC for a unique and exciting morning or afternoon of choral collaboration and performance. Students will form a mass choir with the singers of the Canadian Chamber Choir to workshop two exciting pieces of choral repertoire. Choirs or small ensembles that come as a group have the option to perform some of their own pieces for the rest of the group and will enjoy a short workshop session with CCC Artistic Director, Dr. Julia Davids. The Canadian Chamber Choir will perform a short programme of inspiring music for all participants. Finally, there will be an informal question and answer period during which students can engage in discussion with the professional singers and the Artistic Director of the CCC.

Who is eligible to participate?

Anyone who loves to sing! The repertoire will be chosen so that equal voice, two-part, SSA, SAB and SATB choruses can all participate. Individual singers who are not part of a choir may also be enrolled by their school; these singers may learn the vocal part that they are the most comfortable with. During the festival, the singers of the Canadian Chamber Choir will sing with your students to model proper vocal and choral habits.

Repertoire:

Repertoire will be decided in conjunction with participating choir directors.

Participant choirs will be required to provide their own copies of the music.

What are the benefits?

There are so many benefits to participating in the Choral Collaboration Festival. For young singers at schools without a large vocal program, this festival is a chance for them to sing in a large ensemble. For choirs, this festival is a great opportunity to perform in a mass choir alongside professional singers, receive valuable adjudication as well as learn new choral repertoire. For music teachers and choral directors, this is an opportunity to observe new teaching and conducting techniques, to learn new repertoire, and is a wonderful opportunity to inspire your music students through an afternoon which celebrates the joy of choral singing.

Is this a competition?

No - this festival is a collaborative event. Singers will prepare the two group selections in advance and will work together to find greater musical expression. Individual ensembles will receive comments, choral tips and encouragement from the conductor and singers of the Canadian Chamber Choir.

How does this fit with my curriculum?

The Choral Collaboration workshop will emphasize the process involved in the performance of music by developing vocal technique and skill, musical expressiveness and artistic creativity. Choristers will participate in vocal technique activities, choral rehearsals and performances that will teach them to listen and perform with understanding. Choral Collaboration has a uniquely Canadian focus in the mass choir repertoire as well as the artistic staff and guest choir. Choristers will also have the chance to interact in musical dialogue with professional musicians and observe how skills developed in music are applied in various music-related careers.

Artistic Director - Julia Davids

Dr. Julia Davids is a proud founding member of the Canadian Chamber Choir. Originally from London, Ontario, she has forged a career as a versatile performer, educator and conductor. As a soprano soloist, Ms. Davids is an avid performer and recitalist, having appeared with Opera Atelier, the Vancouver Cantata Singers, the Toronto Chamber Choir, the Toronto Consort, the Guelph Chamber Choir, the Aradia Ensemble, and the Publick Musick.

As a conductor, Dr. Davids directed the 2006 Nova Scotia Youth Choir tour. She is on faculty at Loyola University where she teaches a large studio of voice students as well as conducting the choirs. Dr. Davids also serves as Director of Music Ministries at Trinity United Methodist Church and conducts the Camerata Singers of Lake Forest. She has degrees in education, voice performance and conducting from the University of Western Ontario, the University of Michigan, and a DM from Northwestern University.

The Canadian Chamber Choir/Choeur de chambre du Canada (CCC) is a national choral ensemble that provides a professional choral environment for emerging Canadian singers, conductors and composers.
